

"Overall, this experience is important to me because it's the opportunity of a lifetime. If I do not go abroad now, I do not know when in life I will have the same opportunity."

The GCC scholarship is awarded to FSU undergraduate students enrolled in the GCC and the Garnet & Gold Scholar Society who would like to use the scholarship funds to participate in one of <u>FSU's Global Exchange Programs</u>.
