Mukeshimana is the founder and executive director of Genocide Survivors Support Network, which helps survivors rebuild their lives, and it advocates for the prevention of genocide through education. She currently serves on UNHCR, the UN Refugee Agency's Refugee Congress, as an honorary delegate representing the State of Maryland.
