Students Study Internationally Through FSU's Global Exchanges: Apply by February 1

This spring 37 students are studying internationally at 16 partner universities in 10 different countries and areas through FSU's <u>Global Exchanges</u>. Students will be studying in France, Netherlands, China, Australia, Taiwan, UK, Spain, New Zealand, Japan, and Germany. Ten of these 37 have already completed the fall semester on an exchange and are excited to remain for an additional semester.

Savannah Mikus, FSU senior studying Chinese and Japanese Culture and Language, is one of the 10 students continuing her academic year exchange at Kwansei Gakuin University in Nishinomiya, Japan. Mikus has aspirations of becoming a translator after graduation and chose to study abroad with the intent of refining her language skills.

"This experience has given me first-hand experience with Japanese culture," Mikus said. "I feel as though I can localize things better and I have a better understanding of how Japanese society functions."
