Join Us for Virtual International Coffee Hour Featuring Eritrea

Join us for virtual International Coffee Hour, Friday, April 3, featuring Eritrea live from Chef Jesse's home kitchen starting at 5 p.m. on Zoom.

We will be joined by Ermias Tesfamariam, PhD student in Civil and Environmental Engineering, and Tsegai Yhdego, PhD student in Industrial Engineering, who will introduce us to Eritrea, a country known for its rich culture, history, and hospitality.

"A place with its people living in harmony, Eritrea has unique alphabets and experiences three seasons in just two hours' drive," Ermias said. He and Tsegai will help us understand the cultural significance of Himbasha, a slightly sweetened bread that is served on special occasions, as Chef Jesse demonstrates how to make it.

Following the demonstration, we will move right into a more familiar format of International Coffee Hour: gathering in smaller groups for conversation. Instead of meeting around tables, you will be placed in Zoom groups for discussion.
