The CGE staff would like to once again assure all of our international students that FSU is working very hard to ensure that your fall schedules will meet the new immigration guidelines for fall enrollment that came out Monday, July 6.

(To our community members who may not be aware of the new ruling, [please read here](#).) The ruling requires international students to have at least one three-credit face-to-face or hybrid class for fall and removed the previous exemption granted to international students for spring and summer to switch to online classes due to COVID-19.

The Provost, Deans, Department Chairs and many others across FSU have been in constant meetings since Tuesday morning to ensure that each of our international students is enrolled in at least one face-to-face or hybrid class for fall so that they can continue full-time study at FSU.
